#### Member Incentive

Attention all members! To show our appreciation of those who step in and help, this year we're offering a special incentive: we will refund half of your membership fees to you. There are some important stipulations you need to be aware of.

# Paying Fees

#### All fees must be paid by 6:30 PM.

Fees paid in-person can be made by cash or by check. Credit card payments are not accepted at the shack

We are working on an on-line system that allows for multiple person transactions. Credit card fees have been updated to 2.9% + 30¢, a significant reduction from the previous \$5.

Once the office closes, it will no longer be possible to pay your fees. If you have not paid by the designated time or notified the office you are scratching, you will be marked as a no-show and fined a \$10 fee.

If you anticipate being late or prefer to avoid arriving early, we encourage you to pay online.
